R. M. C. THIRD AMENDMENT TO PROTECTIVE COVENANTS

APPLICABLE TO A SUBDIVISION KNOWN AS STONEWOOD, NEAR THE CITY OF FOUNTAIN INN, SOUTH CAROLINA, THE ORIGINAL PLAT OF WHICH IS RECORDED IN THE R.M.C. OFFICE IN PLAT BOOK WWW, at PAGE 30, A SUBSEQUENT PLAT OF WHICH IS RECORDED IN THE R.M.C. OFFICE IN PLAT BOOK 4F AT PAGE 13, THE ORIGINAL PROTECTIVE COVENANTS ARE RECORDED IN DEED BOOK 866 AT PAGE 166, AND AN AMENDMENT TO PROTECTIVE COVENANTS IS RECORDED IN DEED BOOK 882 AT PAGE 139, A SECOND AMENDMENT TO PROTECTIVE COVENANTS IS RECORDED IN DEED BOOK 883 AT PAGE 233.

WHEREAS, S. & W., Incorporated imposed certain protective covenants upon a Subdivision known as STONEWOOD, as shown on a plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book WWW at Page 30, said Restrictions being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 866 at Page 166; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the protective covenants applicable to STONEWOOD were recorded in Deed Volume 882 at Page 139 and, Deed Volume 883 at Page 233, and

WHEREAS, STONEWOOD, has been replated and a subsequent plat has been recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4F at Page 16, and

WHEREAS, the undersigned represents the ownership of all of the lots in STONEWOOD shown on plats recorded in Plat Book WWW, Page 30 and Plat Book 4F at Page 13, and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, and in order to refer to and describe the Subdivision property affected by the Protective Covenants and Amendment to Protective Covenants, as shown on the subsequent plat, this Third Amendment to Protective Covenants is executed and recorded for the purpose of referring to the subsequent plat as recorded in Plat Book 4F at Page 16, and to adopt all prior amendments to said restrictions.
