Styles of Greenville County, South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred and no/100 (\$900.00) Dollars to them paid on behalf of the South Carolina State Highway Department, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have for themselves, their heirs, executors and assigns, released, acquit and forever discharged the South Carolina State Highway Department, its agents, employees and servants of and from any kind and all actions, causes of action, claims, damages or demands of whatever name or nature or in any manner arisen, arising or to grow out of the reconstruction and maintenance of Route 183, File 23.596, across or adjacent to the property of Pickens E. Freeman Estate. This release covers all past, present or future and prospective damages that might result or be claimed to result from the construction, reconstruction, maintenance and operation of the Department's highways, right-of-way and drainage facilities, as presently exist, *except that the issue as to the installation of gates in pasture fences on lands of the undersigned and as to drainage ditch in the pasture is not covered hereby and is left open.*

It is further acknowledged that there is no agreement or promise on the part of the Highway Department to do or omit to do any act or thing not herein mentioned, and that the above consideration is in full settlement of any and all damages to the undersigned, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, arising from or out of any and all matters aforementioned.
