C., dated April 11, 1950, Plats of Blocks 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book X at Pages 143-157, inclusive. The lot above described and herein conveyed fronts on Second Avenue approximately 79.85 feet.
