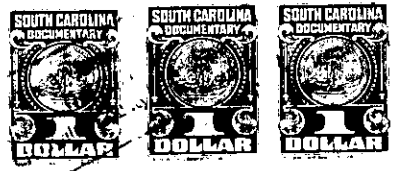
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that We, Bill B. Bozeman and Joseph H. Earle, Jr.
