KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Richard G. Pace

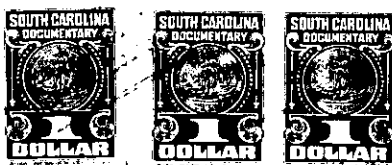
in consideration of One Thousand Five Hundred and No/100-----(\$1,500.00)----- Dollars,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 12 and the Westernmost portion of Lot No. 11 as shown on a plat of the property of R. L. Hallman, Jr. and M. L. Propps, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book KK at Page 94, and having the following courses and distances:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northern side of Piedmont Avenue Extension at a point common with Lots No. 12 and 13 of said plat and running N. 13-17 E. 143.1 feet; thence S. 79-43 E. 160.1 feet; thence S. 13-17 W. 150.3 feet; thence N. 76-43 W. 160 feet to the point of beginning and being the same property conveyed by Jerry R. Hooper and Gloria C. Hooper to Richard G. Pace and Lila W. Pace by deed dated July 3, 1965 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 777 at Page 71.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance the Grantees assume and agree to pay a note and mortgage executed by Jerry R. Hooper and Gloria C. Hooper on May 22, 1961 in the original sum of \$8,500.00 of which there is now a balance of \$6,621.95, (\$6,772.00, however having been assumed), the mortgage being recorded in said RMC Office in Mortgage Book 858 at Page 311.
