

has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said

CHARLES SMITH AND ANNETTE SMITH, THEIR HEIRS AND ASSIGNS:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the Town of Taylors, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, the same being shown as Lots Fifty-one (51) and Sixty (60) on a plat of Chick Springs Township prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated August, 1947, and recorded in Plat Book "S" at page 19 in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, also shown on a plat prepared for Charles Smith and Annette Smith by Robert E. Collingwood, Jr., dated August 18, 1970, to be recorded, and having the following boundaries and measurements:
