COUNTY	OF	GREENVILLE	, ,	PROPERTY SETTLEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this the 30th day of October, 1970, between ELDEN CARROLL, hereinafter called "Husband", and BEATRICE Y. CARROLL, hereinafter called "Wife", both now residing in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, but planning to depart this County and State and reside in other parts of the country.

WHEREAS, Husband and Wife were lawfully married, but unfortunate differences have arisen between them which make it impossible, at least temporarily, for them to live together as Husband and Wife except at the sacrifice of their mutual comfort, health and happiness;

WHEREAS, Husband and Wife are desirous of entering into an agreement under which they may be able to live peaceably separate and apart;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants herein made and of the acts to be performed by the respective parties hereto, Husband and Wife do mutually covenant and agree as follows:

- (1) Husband and Wife do hereby agree to live separate and apart from each other for and during the term of this separation as if each were sole and unmarried and to reside from time to time at such place or places and to conduct, carry on and engage in any employment, business or trade which either of them shall deem fit, without and free from any control, restraint or interference, directly or indirectly, by the other party.
- (2) Neither party shall molest the other, nor compel nor attempt to compel the other to cohabit, with him or her by any legal or other action or proceeding.
