the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto---Vardry L. Johnson, his heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the Town of Piedmont, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known as Lot No. 12, on Plat of Property of Estate of V. L. Johnson, which plat is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4F, Page 28, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northerly side of a County Road, said iron pin being 1,452 feet from the intersection of Pelzer Road and the said County Road, joint front corner Lots 11 and 12; and running thence along said County Road, as the same curves as follows: N. 82-42 W. 50 feet, N. 70-19 W. 60 feet, N. 5-35 W. 100 feet, N. 10-48 E. 100 feet and N. 11-28 E. 173 feet to an iron pin on said County Road; thence N. 83-08 E. 81.6 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots 11 and 12; thence S. 2-31 W. 398.1 feet to an iron pin on said County Road, the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to any restrictions, rights-of-way, or easements that may appear of record on the recorded plat(s) or on the premises.
