unto Robert L. Perry, III, his heirs and assigns, forever:

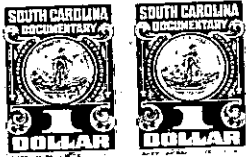
ALL my undivided right, title and interest, the same being a one-fourth (1/4),
in and to:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of
South Carolina, located on the south side of Seventh Street and being known and
designated as Lot No. 31, of Section 4, of JUDSON MILLS VILLAGE, as shown by
plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 'K' at Pages 75 and 76 in the RMC Office for
Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Seventh Street at the joint front
corner of Lot 31 and 32; and running thence S. 1-42 E. 118.7 feet to an iron
pin; thence S. 88-05 W. 83 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-42 W. 118.8 feet to
an iron pin on Seventh Street; thence with the edge of Seventh Street N. 88-10 E.
83 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same property conveyed to David A. Brissey by deed recorded in
Deed Volume 232 at Page 25 in the RMC Office for Greenville County. David A.
Brissey died testate on September 3, 1967, and according to the terms of his will
probated in Apartment 1004, File 15, in the Probate Court for Greenville County,
left all of his property to his wife Ethel R. Brissey. Ethel Reynolds Brissey
died intestate on June 8, 1969, and as shown on record of her estate filed in
Apartment 1099, File 12, the grantor herein was one of four children who were
the sole heirs at law and distributees of Ethel Reynolds Brissey.
