WHEREAS William Murphy has for some time been a patient at the South Carolina State Hospital, and as a patient has become well and truly indebted to the Mental Health Commission for room and board as provided by statute; and

WHEREAS there has been filed upon the public records of Greenville County a lien for such room and board against any property owned by William Murphy; and

WHEREAS it is the desire of the Mental Health Commission to release, for valuable consideration, the interest of William Murphy in certain property owned by his deceased brother, said interest being that received by William Murphy as an heir of his deceased brother, Frank Murphy;

NOW THEREFORE, know all men by these present that the Mental Health Commission does hereby release any and all liens held by it against the property of William Murphy, the following described land:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the southwest side of a County Road leading from Cross Road School south toward Greenville, S. C., and bounded by lands of J. H. Rainey and J. T. Rainey, containing one acre, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap in the center of a road on J. T. Rainey's line, and running thence with the County Road, N. 26-14 W. 200 feet to a nail and cap; thence S. 46-50 W., over iron pin on bank of road, 240.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 26-14 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence with J. T. Rainey's line, N. 46-50 E. 240.2 feet over iron pin on the bank of the County Road to the beginning corner.

Being the same property of which Frank Murphy died seized and possessed.
