

5) To borrow any sum or sums of money on such terms and with such security, whether real or personal property, as my attorney may deem fit, and for that purpose to execute all promissory notes, mortgages and other instruments which may be necessary to the transaction, the lender not being responsible for the application of the proceeds.

6) In general to do all other acts, deeds, matters and things in or about my estate, property and affairs, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I could do in my own proper person if personally present.
