KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that William B. James and Leo H. Hill of Greenville County, South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Nineteen Hundred and no/100 (\$1900.00) Dollars to them paid on behalf of the South Carolina State Highway Department, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have for themselves, their heirs, executors and assigns, released, acquitted and forever discharged the South Carolina State Highway Department, its agents, employees and servants of and from any and all actions, causes of action, claims, damages or demands of whatever name or nature or in any manner arisen, arising or to grow out of the reconstruction and maintenance of Route 123, File 23.566, across or adjacent to the property of William B. James and Leo H. Hill. This release covers all past, present or future and prospective damages that might result or be claimed to result from the construction, reconstruction, maintenance and operation of the Department's highways, right-of-way and drainage facilities, as presently exist.

It is further acknowledged that there is no agreement or promise on the part of the Highway Department to do or omit to do any act or thing not hereinmentioned, and that the above consideration is in full settlement of any and all damages to the undersigned, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, arising from or out of any and all matters aforementioned.
