To negotiate, bargain and sell and execute any bills of sale necessary to sell, transfer or otherwise alienate any personal property belonging to me;

To negotiate and deal with and handle any and all real estate owned by me, of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situated, including all of my real estate and/or personal property in the State of Florida, and to sign any and all deeds, mortgages, contracts and other papers as may be necessary to transfer any interest in such real estate that I may have, now or at any time in the future;

To execute any medical authorizations or other papers as may be needed by any doctors, nurses, hospital or nursing homes in connection with my business or personal affairs and to sign any and all government papers of whatsoever nature and description as may be necessary for my maintenance, health, comfort and well-being.
