ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Tract No. 1 of the J. H. Cothran lands, containing 31.32 acres according to a survey made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, December, 1938, and having according to said survey the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
