If prior to the termination of this Trust as hereinabove provided, the Trustee herein named shall cease to act as such by reason of death, resignation or for any other reason, then, and in such event, Elizabeth F. Wherry is hereby designated as Successor Trustee hereunder, and upon acceptance thereof, shall have and exercise all the rights, powers and duties, discretionary and otherwise, herein conferred upon the original Trustee.

The Trustee and Successor Trustee herein named will receive no compensation for his or her services. No bond or other security shall be required in any jurisdiction of the Trustee or Successor Trustee herein named.

Any Trustee hereunder may resign by filing with the Judge of the Probate Court of Greenville County, his or her written resignation at least thirty (30) days prior to the desired resignation date and by making a full and final accounting of all his or her acts and doings and transferring and delivering to the Successor Trustee herein named, or as the case may be, to such Trustee as may be appointed by said Court, all assets in hand belonging to the Trust Estate. Upon approval by the Court of the final accounting and, if necessary, after appointment by the Court of a Successor Trustee, such resignation shall be approved, and the resigning Trustee discharged from any further liability hereunder.
