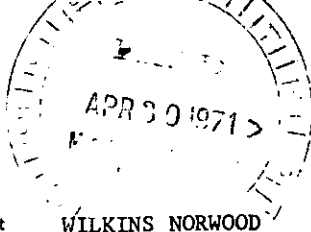

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that WILKINS NORWOOD

in consideration of Five Hundred and No/100ths (\$500.00)----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto AIMEE SLOAN NORWOOD, as substituted Trustee for Wilkins Norwood under Deed of Trust dated January 27, 1942:

All that tract of land in Ward 5 of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Casey Street at a point 118 feet South from an alley which runs from Green Avenue to Anderson Street, and thence running along Casey Street 30 feet 7 inches to a stake in the line of F.M. Burnett property; thence along that line in a Westerly direction 82 feet 10 inches to stake; thence in a northerly direction 24 feet 8 inches to stake; thence in an easterly direction 78 feet 11 inches to the beginning.

The property hereinabove described is conveyed to Aimee Sloan Norwood, as substituted Trustee under the terms and provisions of a deed of trust dated January 27, 1942, and said deed of trust being duly recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Book of Deeds 242, page 191, reference is made to Judgment Roll E-203 in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, and the said Aimee Sloan Norwood was duly substituted as Trustee under the terms and provisions of said Trust pursuant to Decree of the Court of Common Pleas by Honorable J. Robert Martin, Jr., Resident Judge, dated December 28, 1949.
