for and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand Eight Hundred and no/100ths (\$5,800.00) - - - - - dollars, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto RICHARD ALEXANDER STANFORD and LOUISE WILLIAMS STANFORD

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northwestern side of Dundee Lane, in Paris Mountain Township, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 30 of a subdivision known as Stratford Forest, and having according to a plat of said subdivision prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated February 25, 1957, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book KK at page 89, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Dundee Lane at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 29 and 30 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 29 N. 13-30 W. 221.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 28, 29, 30 and 31 N. 78-35 E. 234.9 feet to an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Dundee Lane, thence with the curve on the Northwestern side of Dundee Lane, the following chords and distances: S. 9-16 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 30-56 W. 140 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 64-09 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to "Protective Covenants Applicable to Stratford Forest" recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 578 at page 1 and to drainage and utility easements, if any, affecting said lot.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Furman University, dated November 13, 1956, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 567 at page 397.
