

ALSO that other tract of land in Saluda Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 50 acres, more or less, bounded on the North by lands now or formerly of Rufus Allen, on the East by J. W. McSwain, on the South by Burrel Cox, and on the West by lands of Tifton, and being the same owned by Mrs. Louisa Phillips Griffin at the time of her death, said tract of land being conveyed to Oscar Barton and G. J. Barton by E. Inman, Master for Greenville County, by deed dated November 21, 1925, and recorded in Book 67, at page 174. Oscar Barton died intestate on the _____ day of March, 1939, leaving as his sole heirs at law and distributees, his wife, Tessie Barton, and his three children, Pearl B. Johnson, Eula B. Bishop and G. J. Barton, and the said 50 acre tract was conveyed by the said Tessie Barton, Pearl B. Johnson, Eula B. Bishop and G. J. Barton, by deed dated September 7, 1946, and recorded in Book 298, at page 330.

ALSO that other tract of land in Saluda Township, County and State aforesaid, about 19 miles from the City of Greenville, two miles East of the Buncombe Road containing approximately 100 acres, bounded on the North by lands now or formerly owned by J. P. Pittman and Emma Choice; on the Northwest by lands now or formerly owned by W. F. Pitman; on the East by land now or formerly owned by J. A. Honour; on the Southeast and South by lands now or formerly owned by Rufus Allen; on the Southwest by lands now or formerly owned by Dublin; on the West by lands of Walker Choice; on the Northwest by lands of Walker Choice and Emma Choice, being the same conveyed by Greer Oil Mill and Feed Company by deed dated December 20, 1950, and recorded in Book 426, at page 9.
