

tion by the holders of not less than a majority of the Shares outstanding, the question as to whether such Conflicting Provision should be continued.

(c) If any provisions of this Declaration of Trust shall be held invalid or unenforceable in any jurisdiction, such invalidity or unenforceability shall attach only to such provision in such jurisdiction and shall not in any manner affect or render invalid or unenforceable such provision in any other jurisdiction or any other provision of this Declaration of Trust in any jurisdiction.

SECTION 13.5. *Section Headings.* Section headings have been inserted for convenience only and are not a part of this Declaration of Trust.

ARTICLE XIV

DURATION OF TRUST

SECTION 14.1. *Duration.* Subject to possible earlier termination in accordance with the provisions of Article XI hereof, the Trust created hereby shall terminate on the expiration of 20 years after the death of the last survivor of the following named persons:
