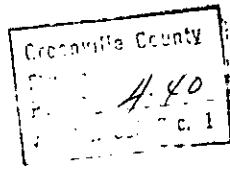

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Mauldin, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 64 on a plat of "Addition to Knollwood Heights, Section 3, prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book WWW at Page 6, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the Southwestern edge of Devon Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 18 and 64 and running thence along a line of Lot 18 S. 48-58 W. 166.03 feet to a point; thence along a line of Lot 19 S. 47-27 E. 40.0 feet to a point; thence along a line of Lot 50 S. 17-10 E. 48.97 feet to a point; thence along a line of Lot 63 N. 67-35 E. 165.65 feet to a point on the Southwestern edge of Devon Drive; thence along Devon Drive N. 27-48 W. 74.0 feet to a point; thence continuing along the Southwestern edge of Devon Dr. N. 34-43 W. 65 feet to the beginning corner and being a portion of the property conveyed by Mary D. Locke, et al, to The Carolina Land Company by deed dated April 6, 1966, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 795 at Page 461.
