in consideration of Twenty five thousand and no/100-----(\$25,000.00)-----Dollars,

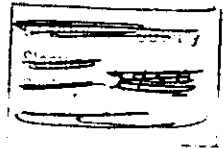

ALL That lot of land situate on the southeastern side of Richardson Street and on the northeastern side of Coffee Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 7 on a plat recorded in Plat Book F at page 87 in the RMC Office for Greenville County and also Lot J as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book H at pages 249 and 250 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, said lots being described collectively as follows:

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the southeastern side of Richardson Street at the southwestern corner of property of Parie Lee Green, et al, and running thence with Green property, S. 69-19 E. 21.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 21-27 W. 69 feet to an iron pin on the northeastern side of Coffee Street; thence with said street, N. 69-19 W. 19.54 feet to an iron pin at intersection of Richardson Street and Coffee Street; thence with Richardson Street, N. 19-47 E. 69 feet to the point of beginning.
