Johnston, Jr., in accordance with that certain Trust Agreement dated August 23, 1968, their successors and assigns forever:

ALL MY INTEREST IN AND TO:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, at the Southern intersection of East Coffee Street and North Irvine Street and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
