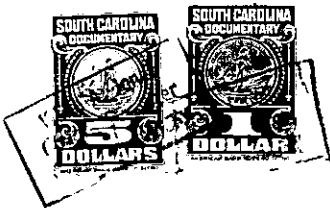

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the Town of Mauldin, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Northwestern side of Knollwood Drive and being known and designated as Lot 33 on a plat of "Revision of Lots 32, 33 and 34 of Addition to Knollwood Heights," recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book 4N at Page 16 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:
