KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that We, Polly P. Crisp and Barbara Jane Roberts, formerly Barbara Jane Forrest,

In consideration of the partition of said property, and also in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

P. D. Forrest, Jr., and Margie B. Forrest, share and share alike, Their Heirs and Assigns Forever:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 2.7 acres, more or less, including road R/W and river areas, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat thereof made by W. R. Williams, Jr., and dated June, 1971, to wit:

BEGINNING at a spike in the center of the River Falls Road, formerly known as Jones Gap Road, and running thence S. 59-32 E. 25 feet to an iron pin in the eastern edge of said road; thence S. 59-32 E. 223 feet to an iron pin near the western side of Middle Saluda River; thence continuing S. 59-32 E. 40 feet to a point in said river; thence courses and distances in said river as follows: S. 65 W. 166 feet to a point, thence S. 26-30 W. 160 feet to a point, thence S. 2.00 W. 107 feet, more or less, to a point; thence leaving said river and running S. 36-00 W. for the following distances: 42 feet to an iron pin, thence 87 feet to a point, thence 9 feet to an old iron pin in the southern edge of the old concrete of Geer Highway #276; thence with the southern edge of said concrete pavement, along the southside of said highway, N. 53 - 30 W. 263.5 feet to a point; thence crossing said highway and running into the River Falls Road, N. 33-00 E. for the following distances from the point last mentioned: 9 feet to a point in said highway, thence 485 feet to the spike at the beginning corner.

The above described property is a portion of the same acquired by the said Daniel Bedford Forrest, deceased, by two deeds, each covering the same property, to wit:

- (2) Deed from Polly P. Crisp and P. D. Forrest, Jr., dated September 24, 1965, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office aforesaid in Deed Book 783 at page 42;

and also by way of inheritance of an undivided interest therein from his father, P. D. Forrest, Sr., deceased.

together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s), and the grantee(s)'s heirs or successors and assigns, forever. And, the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee(s)'s heirs or successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
