to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

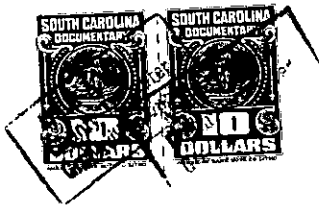
