

transferred to the Trustee, or in exercising any other power hereby conferred unless said Trustee shall have failed to act in good faith or with reasonable care.

5. The Grantor, or any other person, may transfer, assign, convey, deliver to the Trustee, cash, securities, or other property, whether real or personal, satisfactory to the Trustee in which he is willing to accept, to be held upon the trust hereby created, and upon the acceptance and receipt by the Trustee of any such property, the same shall in all respects become subject to the terms and provisions of this Indenture.

6. This Indenture and the trust hereby created shall be and is hereby made irrevocable and neither the Grantor, nor any other person interested hereunder, shall have the right or power to in any way amend, alter, or annul any of the terms hereof.

7. The Trustee herein named shall not receive any compensation for his services.

8. The Trustee hereby acknowledges the receipt of the property described in Schedule "A", hereto attached, to be held, administered and disposed of, in trust, in accordance with the provisions of this Indenture.
