on account of the reservation of an easement or right for the benefit of Pelham Mills contained in a deed from MacMillian C. King to A. P. Burnett, recorded January 9, 1919, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 34 at Page 184.

It is understood that the undersigned do not intend to convey any interest in any property in which they may have an interest in fee and this release and abandonment of water rights shall be limited solely to rights applicable to the property herein described and shall not be construed to be a release or abandonment of any similar rights with regard to any other properties.
