GIEBNER, his heirs and assigns forever:

All of our right, title and interest, if any, in and to the following described property:

All that certain piece, parcel or strip of land along the South side of Walnut Street adjoining property of the grantee in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point at the Northeastern corner of property now owned by the grantee, which point is N. 30-14 W. 79.1 feet from an iron pin on Overbrook Road at the joint corner of property of Raymond M.
