TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, Willie A. Jones County Treasurer of said Greenville County, did issue his warrants directed to the Delinquent Tax Collector for said County and State by authority of the acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina and the statute laws of said State, against Edgar Boyce

defaulting taxpayer(s) of said County, strictly charging and commanding said Delinquent Tax Collector of said County to levy by distress and sale of the lands of the said Edgar Boyce

tax defaulter(s), the sum of \$10.43 including the penalties on said tax execution(s) for the year(s) 1969 together with charges and costs thereof; and

WHEREAS, by virtue and authority of said warrants George F. Miller the delinquent tax collector of the State and County aforesaid, did on the 10th day of September 19 70 seize and take exclusive possession of the said property against which said taxes were assessed and levied, as hereinafter described, and on Sales Day of the month of October during the usual hours of sale, after due advertisement, sell the same to Arthur Brown & Glenda Brown and their heirs and assigns, the purchaser(s), hereinafter known as "grantee(s)," and the highest bidder at such sale, for the sum of Seventy Five & 00/100 and gave a receipt for said purchase money to them; and

WHEREAS, more than twelve months have elapsed since the date of said sale, and the defaulting taxpayer(s), or any other party interested, have failed to redeem said land so sold for taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, George F. Miller, Tax Collector of and for the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of Seventy Five & 00/100 Dollars to me paid by the said grantee(s), Arthur Brown & Glenda Brown

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantee(s), Arthur Brown & Glenda Brown

their heirs and assigns: That certain lot of land near the town of Piedmont fronting approximately 180 Feet on S. C. Hwy. 20 and running thence in an easterly direction to the rear of lot which adjoins property of the P. & W. Railroad, and adjoining on the South side property now or formerly owned by C. R. & D. G. Melton, and on the west side adjoining property now or formerly owned by Andrew W. & Dorothy Burgess. This lot being a portion of the 54½ acre tract conveyed by Maggie S. Hooper to Edgar Boyce by Deed of record in R.M.C. Office for said County in Deed Book 256, page 404.
