14. To Do All Other Things. In general to do all other acts, deeds, matters, and things whatsoever in or about my estate, property, and affairs, or to concur with persons jointly interested with myself therein in doing all acts, deeds, matters, and things herein, either particularly or generally described as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I could do in my own proper person if personally present.

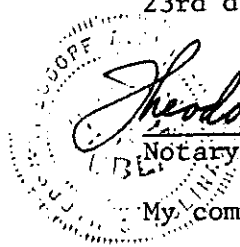
