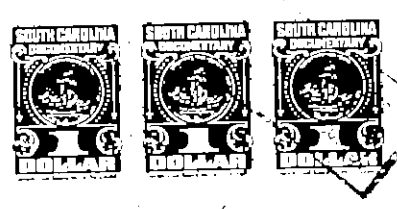
In consideration of Twelve Hundred, Fifty and No/100 (\$1,250.00) Dollars,
