All of my interest in and to;

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, about one mile north from Chick Springs, lying west from the St. Mark Road and on the south side of a new cut road that leads west from the said St. Mark Road, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning on an iron pin on the south side of the said new cut road, said pin being 635 feet west from the St. Mark Road, and runs thence S.22-50 E. 312 feet to an iron pin; thence S.70-25 W. 168 feet to an iron pin in the center of a proposed 16 foot driveway; thence with the center of the driveway N.22-50 W., 312 feet to an iron pin on the south side of the new cut road; thence with the south side of the said road N.70-25 E., 168 feet to the beginning corner.
