REAL PROPERTY AGREEMENT

South Carolina 11-11-71

In consideration of such loans and indebtedness as shall be made by or become due to THE SOUTH CAROLINA NATIONAL BANK OF CHARLESTON (hereinafter referred to as "Bank") to or from the undersigned, jointly or severally, and until all of such loans and indebtedness have been paid in full, or until twenty-one years following the death of the last survivor of the undersigned, whichever first occurs, the undersigned, jointly and severally, promise and agree

- 1. To pay, prior to becoming delinquent, all taxes, assessments, dues and charges of every kind imposed or levied upon the real property described below; and
- 2. Without the prior written consent of Bank, to refrain from creating or permitting any lien or other encumbrance (other than those presently existing) to exist on, and from transferring, selling, assigning or in any manner disposing of, the real property described below, or any interest therein; or any leases, rents or funds held under escrow agreement relating to said premises; and

3. The property referred to by this agreement is described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the west side of Alice St., the same being the corner of William Robinson lot, and running thence along his line S. 75-25 W. 127 ft. to stake; thence S. 14-39 E 85.7 ft. to stake; thence N. 75-25 E 127ft. to stake on Alice St., thence along Alice St. N. 14-39 W 85.7 ft., to the beginning corner, as shown by a survey made by W. J. Riddle, March 31, 1939. This is a part of the lands of George Jackson deceased, which was conveyed to him by M. L. Donaldson, Executor, by deed dated Sept. 20, 1980, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said G'Ville County in Deed Book LL, page 263. The grantors and Grantee hereof, own said land by reason on the Will of George Jackson, on file in the Office of the Probate Court for said G'Ville County. The said George Jackson being the father of Addie Robinson, and the other grantors and grantees are all children of the said Addie Robinson.

That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof, or if default be made in any payment of principal or interest, on any notes hereof or hereafter signed by the undersigned, the undersigned agrees and does hereby assign the rents and profits arising or to arise from said premises to the Bank and agrees that any judge of jurisdiction may, at chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver of the described premises, with full authority to take possession thereof and collect the rents and profits and hold the same subject to the further order of said court.

4. That if default be made in the performance of any of the terms hereof, or if any of said rental or other sums be not paid to Bank when due, Bank, at its election, may declare the entire remaining unpaid principal and interest of any obligation or indebtedness then remaining unpaid to Bank to be due and payable forthwith.

5. That Bank may and is hereby authorized and permitted to cause this instrument to be recorded at such time and in such places as Bank, in its discretion, may elect.

6. Upon payment of all indebtedness of the undersigned to Bank this agreement shall be and become void and of no effect, and until then it shall apply to and bind the undersigned, their heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, and inure to the benefit of Bank and its successors and assigns. The affidavit of any officer or department manager of Bank showing any part of said indebtedness to remain unpaid shall be and constitute conclusive evidence of the validity, effectiveness and continuing force of this agreement and any person may and is hereby authorized to rely thereon.
