ALL those pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being on the eastern side of Second Avenue (Bigby Street) in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot Numbers six (6) and seven (7) of Block B, on a plat of Jefferson Heights dated October, 1912, prepared by William D.
