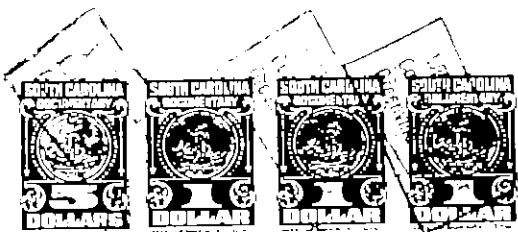
in consideration of Four Thousand and No/100 (\$4,000.00)----- Dollars,

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Austin Township, on the southwestern side of Bethany Road, being known and designated as Lot No. 3 of the Property of Harold L. Cooper as shown on a plat thereof prepared by C. O. Riddle, R. L. S., dated August 30, 1971, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap in the center of Bethany Road, joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 54-45 W. 926.8 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly owned by Robert Earl and Anne M.
