An undivided two-thirds interest in and to the following described property:

Tract No. 1: All that certain lot or parcel of land situate in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, on Highway N. 247, about six miles Northeast of the Town of Belton, in the State of South Carolina, containing One (1) acre, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds as shown by plat made by T. J. Leslie, Registered Surveyor, dated September 19, 1950, and shown as portion "A" on said plat: Beginning at a corner in center of Highway No. 247, running N-8-15-W 368.2 feet to corner, thence S-77-50-E 139.1 feet to corner, thence S-8-15-E 289.93 feet to corner in center of Highway No. 247, thence S-70-25-W 134 feet to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of James Andy Holliday, Mrs. Myrtle Holliday and Highway No. 247.

Tract No. 2: All that certain lot or parcel of land situate in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, about six miles Northeast of the Town of Belton, on Highway No. 247, containing two thirds (2/3) of an acre, more or less, having the following metes and bounds, as shown by a plat made by T. J. Leslie, Registered Surveyor, dated September 19, 1950: Beginning at a corner in the center of Highway No. 247, and running N-8-15-W 289.3 feet to corner, thence S-60-35-E 250 feet to corner in center of said Highway, thence along said Highway 245.5 feet to the beginning corner.
