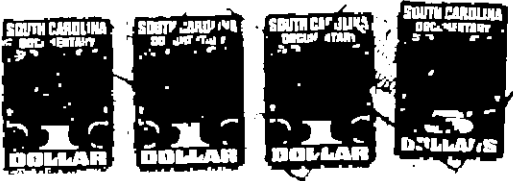

Crowder, and C. W. Quinn, and containing 7-17 acres, more or less, according to survey by J. Earl Freeman, July 8, 1936, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Aiken's Chapel Road and on the Eastern side of a lot known also as Old Rutherford Road, running thence along the Eastern side thereof North 10-3 quarters E. 52 feet to an iron pin in the line of the Taylors Lumber Co. property; thence with said property S. 85-3 quarters E. 196 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10-3 quarters W. 24 and one-half feet to an iron pin; thence South 86-3 quarters W. 195 feet to the point of beginning.
