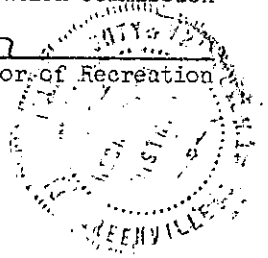

Received of the AMERICAN TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY One and no/100 Dollars, (\$1.00), in consideration of which the undersigned hereby grant and convey unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, its and their respective successors, assigns, lessees and agents, a right of way and easement to construct, operate, maintain, replace and remove such communication systems as the grantees may from time to time require, consisting of underground cables, wires, conduits, manholes, drains and splicing boxes, and surface testing-terminals, repeaters and markers, and other appurtenances, upon, over and under a strip of land one rod wide across the land which the undersigned own or in which the undersigned have any interest in with the one rod strip to be located where the Grantee has an aerial telephone cable in Butler Springs Park, Township of Butler, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, together with the following rights: Of ingress and egress over and across the lands of the undersigned to and from said strip for the purpose of exercising the rights herein granted; to place surface markers beyond said strip; to clear and keep cleared all trees, roots, brush and other obstructions from the surface and subsurface of said strip; install gates in any fences crossing said strip. The southerly boundary of said one rod strip shall be a line parallel to and five feet southerly of the first cable laid, which cable shall have its location indicated upon surface markers set at intervals on the land of the undersigned or on adjacent lands. The undersigned for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby covenant that no structure shall be erected or permitted on said strip. The grantees agree to pay for damage to fences and growing crops arising from the construction and maintenance of the aforesaid systems.
