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DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Mary Bell Jordan; Maude Browning; Marie Wilson; M. C. Gilreath; Grady Gilreath; Ruby Gilreath; Nettie Sue Gilbert; Thelma Shirley; Lucille Gilreath; Edna Lollis; Johnny Gilreath; Frederick Gilreath; in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar, love and affection, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Ruby Gilreath, her heirs and assigns forever all of our right, title and interest in and to the following described property:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing one and two tenths acres, more or less, and being known as part of Lot No. 2 in Arden Sub-division; and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point in a public road leading to Pelzer, and running thence N. 72 W. 5 chains 14 links to center of Smythe Lane; thence along center of Smythe Lane S. 21 W. 2.35 chains to a point; thence S. 72 E. 5.14 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 21 E. 2.35 chains to the point of beginning; and being the same property conveyed by E. A. Roach to Fred Gilreath by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 300, at page 39:
