the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Kiddie A. Crisp, her heirs and assigns forever

The following described real estate situate in the City and County of Greenville, S.C.: All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate on the north side of West Stone Avenue and being known and designated as the major portion of Lot F on Map 5 of a plat of Stone property recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book "WW" at Page 604 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the north side of West Stone Avenue at the corner of property owned by Earle Street Baptist Church and running thence N. 5-30 E. 145 2/3 feet more or less to a point at the corner of property heretofore carved out of Lot F and conveyed to the grantee by Deed recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 401 at Page 491; thence following the common line of said lots S. 84-30 E. 54 1/3 feet more or less to a point; thence with the common line of property now or formerly of Marie S. Phillips S. 5-30 W. 145 2/3 feet more or less to a point on the north side of West Stone Avenue; thence with the North side of said Avenue N. 84-30 W. 54 1/3 feet more or less to the beginning point.

The above is all of the property deeded to B. B. Crisp by deed recorded in Deed Book 68 at Page 213, less that portion deeded to Earle Street Baptist Church in Deed Book 410 at Page 491.

B. B. Crisp died December 22, 1959. No will has been located. He had no children.

The grantor is the son of Hugh Willis Crisp, a brother of B. B. Crisp, who died testate on March 20, 1970 in Dade County Florida, leaving his property to his widow, Pauline S. Crisp.
