

lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe line or lines all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger or interfere with the proper operation of or access to the same.

It is understood and agreed that the right-of-way to be used under this contract is to be thirty (30) feet in width (and lies on the Eastern side and is contiguous to and runs along the fifty (50) foot right-of-way described in Deed Book 393, Page 83) throughout the entire length which is approximately one hundred and thirty-one (131) feet more or less, and the damage, which THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA, is to be liable for during construction, is to be confined to this strip and nothing beyond. The location of the pipe line or lines, when laid, will determine the definite location of the right-of-way. The center of the pipe line or lines shall be accepted as lying five (5) feet from the western boundary line of this right-of-way. The remaining twenty-five (25) feet of said right-of-way shall lie east of the center of said pipe line or lines and the entire right-of-way may be used for the purpose of installing the pipe line or lines. The location of said pipe line or lines is to be approximately along the line as now located and staked out by the engineers, subject to a variation of not exceeding five (5) feet either way and no obstruction shall hereafter be placed on said thirty (30) foot right-of-way.

If in laying the pipe line or lines, it is necessary to cut any timber from the right-of-way, such timber shall be
