All that parcel or lot of land containing three acres, more or less, situated on the south side of Barton's Chapel Road, near the Village of Oneal and northward therefrom, Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having courses and distances according to survey and plat of the property of A.B. Brown and Inez L. Brown by Terry T. Dill, Registered Surveyor, dated June 22, 1957, as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING in the Barton's Chapel Road at a culvert pipe, corner of Ansel Robertson lot, and running thence along the Robertson line, S. 19-18 E. 622.2 feet to an iron pin on the Willimon line; thence along the Willimon line, S. 68-22 E. 100 feet to an iron pin on line of Jessie Bramlett; thence along the Bramlett line, N. 5-00 E. 600 feet to a nail in Barton's Chapel Road; thence along said road, N. 84-18 W. 350.6 feet to the beginning corner.
