the same unto Janice D. Brown,

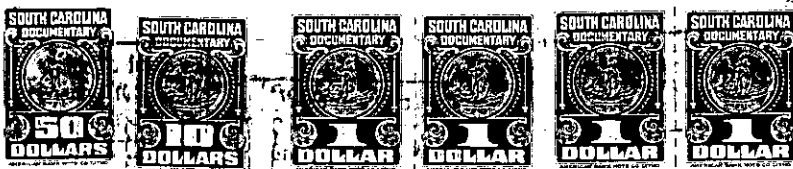
