(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Fred W. Lister

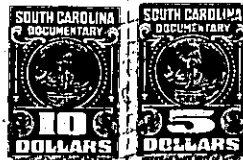
his heirs and assigns:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina containing approximately six-acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the intersection of Jordan Road, known as S. C. Highway No. 277 and Few's Chapel Road, known as S. C. Highway No. S-23-113 and running thence N 1 W 99 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Was Stokes and the tract this day conveyed to Kenneth Forrester and Bernice A. Forrester; thence along the center of Barnett Road N 14 E 601 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Forrester and Bertha J. Stokes; thence along Bertha J. Stokes S 75 W 369.2 feet to an iron pin in the center of Jordan Road; thence S 79-30 W 330 feet to an iron pin at the corner of John E. Herman; thence S 18-30 E 660 feet to an iron pin in the center of Few's Chapel Road; thence along the center of said Road N 72 E 330 feet to the point of beginning, and being a portion of a tract designated as 67.3 acres conveyed to the grantors by deed of the Master in Deed Book 940 at page 273.

32.5 acres was conveyed to John Earle Forrester and 32.5 acres was conveyed to Kenneth Forrester and Bernice A. Forrester according to a new survey entitled T. M. Stokes Estate recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book SSS, page 526, and this conveyance to Lister represents the balance of the 67.3 acres conveyed to the grantors by the Master.
