KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Carl V. Hanvey and Ruth G. Hanvey

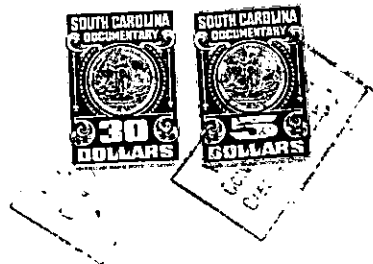
in consideration of Seventeen Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$17,500.00) ----- Dollars,
