the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto J. F. Brannock and Louise J. Brannock, their heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the eastern side of Wilton Street in the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and being the identical property conveyed to William M. James by the Peoples National Bank as Trustee under the will of George T. Walker by deed recorded in Deed Book 339 at Page 433 and is described in said deed as follows:

BEGINNING at the corner of Alley and the eastern side of Wilton Street and running thence with said Alley S. 83-15 E., approximately 146 feet; running thence S. 6-47 W., 50 feet to a corner of property now or formerly of Mrs. Lois C. This property is shown on the Greenville County Block Book as lot 8.1, block 2, page 5, district 500.

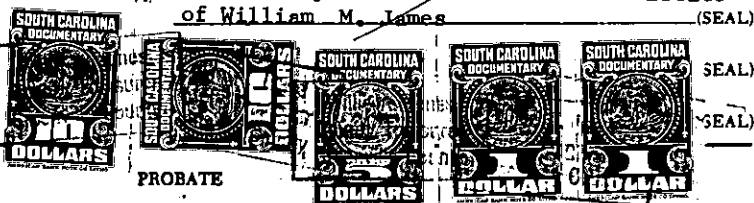
