WHEREAS, under the building restrictions applicable

to a subdivision known as Augusta Acres, recorded in the  
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in  
Deeds Book 391, Page 75, an architectural committee was  
created for the purpose of examining and approving plans.

placed, or altered in the subdivision, and

WHEREAS, two of the original members of the  
original architectural committee are now dead, and the  
undersigned, the sole surviving member, is no longer able  
to act because of her physical condition, and

WHEREAS, the building restrictions give to her  
full authority to designate successors in the event of  
death or resignation of any member of the committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority con-  
tained in the building restrictions applicable to Augusta  
Acres, I, Vivian W. Workman, as the sole surviving member  
of the architectural committee of Augusta Acres, do hereby  
name and appoint, in lieu of W. D. Workman and J. C. Upton,  
now deceased, and Vivian W. Workman, who herewith resigns,  
being the original architectural committee, the persons  
hereafter named to be the members of and to constitute the  
architectural committee of the subdivision known as Augusta  
Acres, with all of the rights, powers, and duties granted  
to the architectural committee in the building restrictions  
of the subdivision known as Augusta Acres, recorded in  
said R. M. C. Office in Deeds Book 391, Page 75:
