RIGHT-OF-WAY AGREEMENT

ELIZABETH RIDDLE<sup>R.M.C.</sup> IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, the Poinsett Brick and Tile Company does hereby grant and convey unto the Parker Water and Sewer Subdistrict Commission, its successors and assigns, the right-of-way across the property of the Poinsett Brick and Tile Company located on the north side of White Horse Road, Greenville County, South Carolina, for the purposes of laying, constructing and maintaining a water line, which water line is to be located between the Poinsett Brick and Tile Company property line adjacent to the American Legion Fair Association property and the South ditch of a road which the Poinsett Brick and Tile Company claims it owns. The Parker Water and Sewer Subdistrict Commission shall have full and free rights of access on and across the property of the grantor for the purpose of constructing, laying, installing and maintaining this water line and/or a sewer line.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the said Poinsett Brick and Tile Company, a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of South Carolina, has, by its duly authorized officers, hereunto set its seal this 28 day of October, 1952.
