ELIZABETH RIDDWHEREAS, the School District of Greenville County has R.M.C. heretofore installed a water line in and along White Horse Road, South Carolina Highway 250 and Anderson Road, South Carolina Highway 81; as shown by a plat made by J. E. Sirrine and Company, engineers, dated February 22, 1955.

WHEREAS, the Parker Water and Sewer District is willing to accept a conveyance of the said line and including said lines among the lines serviced and maintained by the said Parker Water and Sewer District, provided that title to said line be vested in said Parker Water and Sewer District, NOW THEREFORE,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned, School District of Greenville County, does hereby, grant, bargain, sell, release and convey unto the Parker Water and Sewer District, a public corporation, its successors and assigns forever;

All that certain water line, including all pipes, valves, tees, hydrants, boxes and all property of every nature in connection with said water line together with all easements, rights of way and appurtenances thereto extending from point where the water lines of School District of Greenville County connects with the existing lines of Parker Water and Sewer District, the same beginning at the point where said water line connects to existing 12 inch by 6 inch plugged gross in the intersection of Anderson Road, South Carolina Highway 81, and White Horse Road, South Carolina Highway 250, being shown on said plat as station 13 plus 27, and running in a southwesterly direction to station 12 plus 85, which station is located three feet west of the northwestern side of Anderson Road, South Carolina Highway 81, to a 45 degree bend and running in a generally southwesterly direction, continuing three feet from the edge of said Highway to station ten plus 76, thence a 90 degree bend and crossing said Highway in a southeasterly direction to station ten plus 50, which station is located three feet southeast from the southeastern side of said Anderson Road, South Carolina Highway 81; thence a 90 degree bend and a line running three feet from the edge of said Highway to station 6 plus 30 which station is on the southeastern side of said Anderson Road, South Carolina Highway 81.
