WATER LINE CONVEYANCE

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to it in hand paid, and in consideration of other valuable considerations satisfactory to it, and pursuant to the terms and conditions of contract entered into on the 9th day of March, 1964, Dempsey Construction Company, Inc., by its duly authorized officer, Ray T. Dempsey, President, does hereby transfer and convey to Parker Water and Sewer Sub-District of Greater Greenville Sewer District an eight inch cast iron water line running approximately 1,168 feet along the Staunton Bridge Road in Greenville County, South Carolina, to the intersection of such Road with Patti Drive, and a six inch cast iron water line approximately 1,400 feet in length down Patti Drive in a generally westerly direction, such lines being constructed and tied into the mains of the Parker Water and Sewer Sub-District in accordance with the aforementioned contract of March 9, 1964, and the property served by such lines having now become a part of Parker Water and Sewer Sub-District of Greater Greenville Sewer District, such lines are now being conveyed to Parker. There are also conveyed by this instrument all valves, fittings, fire hydrants and other appurtenances to such line as they now exist, as shown on drawing attached, labeled "Dempsey Construction Co., Inc. to Parker Water & Sewer Sub-District September 21, 1965".

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the aforementioned lines to Parker Water and Sewer Sub-District, its successors and assigns forever.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said Dempsey Construction Company, Inc., by its duly authorized officer, has hereunto set its hand and affixed its seal this 21<sup>st</sup> day of September, 1965.
